Administrator Report

To: Academic Policy Committee

There were four students who were placed on Academic Contracts this quarter. One of those students completed their contract and the other three had to have their contract extended another 15 days.

We are preparing to do the new PEAK assessment in April. The staff chose to conduct testing from April 17-28 (The state window is from March 28-April 28). Since this is a new computer based assessment the staff wanted to let the testing start at other sites to ensure it works out any problems before we started our testing.

I nominated Suzi Phillips to the VFW as an outstanding teacher in the area of citizenship and she was recognized as the Middle School Teacher of the Year for the State of Alaska by the VFW.

Roger Scarborough has resigned as an Aide, but he plans on finishing this year out. I will be talking with the staff about the need to replace him. I anticipate replacing his position as it is currently, a full time Aide.

There seems to be a conflict about who is supposed to evaluate the principal of a charter school. This is the response that was sent out by DEED: *The district is responsible for the evaluation of the charter school principal as required under AS 14.20.149 and 4 AAC 19, unless the district, the charter's school academic policy committee, and, if applicable, the affected bargaining unit agrees to a different arrangement and have been granted an exemption from the requirement, under AS 14.03.255(b)(14). As the academic policy committee has the authority to select a principal, it also retains the authority to dismiss a principal.*

I met with Dave Jones and Julie Cisco on March 2, 2017 to discuss bussing and school lunch options. I will present those options during the meeting.
