In addition Mr McCanna mentioned that he made it clear to the PTC they are under the supervision of the APC, are acting as an extension of APC, and need to present bylaws to APC for approval. PTC is meeting 11-16 to elect "acting officers" pending bylaw approval.

Mr McCanna said a group led by Mrs Phillips will meet under his supervision to discuss dress code details Wednesday 11-9-16 at 3pm.

It was mentioned to Mr McCanna that concern among parents still exists about a "winter Program", rather than a "Christmas Program".

Financial Report

Presented by Mr McCanna & all is in order.

Charter renewal discussion

Mr McCanna said that all is going well with charter renewal, hopefully for a 10yr period. KPBSD concerns are primarily that our lack of a buss & meal program may lead to a lack of economically disadvantaged students. Mr McCanna said he thinks their numbers (2%) are not completely correct due to a lack of data.

Discussion followed.

We will try & accumulate better data.

Mr McCanna may send home a letter asking parents if they would be willing to fill out a form requesting the economic level of school families to please the KPBSD. The form will attempt to compile information regarding household incomes to pass on to KPBSD. Parents will not be required to participate. All reports will be anonymous.

It was pointed out that we currently DO NOT provide lunch or bussing programs & have uniform requirements so that all children will have equal economic status and none will be singled out in the eyes of others.

We will examine options to make economically disadvantaged students successful at ABCS. The KPBSD will meet in December to vote on charter.
